DISCUSSION NOTES	<p>If we do Stories That Soar, we may need to move money to reading line. Reading Seed Program: helps tutor our students by having volunteers come from Literacy Connects.</p> <p>Stories That Soar: students write stories and place in Magic Box and creates skits that are presented to the school. Brought up during leadership team to discuss if we want to keep or not keep the program. The program has gone up to \$3,500. Some idea was to try to do our own magic box. Propose them come in the spring and school does it in the Fall or vice-versa. Laurie: likes the idea of stories that soar but is concerned about the cost. Can this money be used for other literacy funds? Turns out we don't have enough funds to spend on Stories that Soar with the increase in price. We can use the funds for other literacy programs.</p>
